Rhema is a private nursery and primary school set up by Director Mike in Sapiri village, Budaka. The Church tithes and offering help to support 91 children in need. These children are given a chance to walk a pathway toward a brighter future. There are 200 children during the holidays, some go to secondary schools. The Church and Mike pay for the children to access exams at other schools. Your faithful support has already created so many opportunities for these children.



Local women help with meals and make their school uniforms. The women have learnt to make other garments and a sewing box [right]. The school's borehole provides water not only for the children but also for the surrounding community, creating pathways of service and care.

Challenges on the Pathway!

As the children at Rhema Orphanage School grow, so do the challenges they face. To ensure these children can continue walking confidently toward their purpose, urgent improvements are needed. A recent school inspection identified critical priorities, including:

- Building 10 permanent classrooms
- Providing bedframes and better sleeping arrangements
- Constructing latrines and improved sanitation facilities
- Creating a nursery play area for younger children
- Securing qualified teachers and staff housing
